



Reciprocal Play Policy – Glacier Greens Golf Club

Glacier Greens Golf Club is pleased to offer reciprocal playing privileges with select partner clubs. To ensure a smooth and professional experience for both our members and our reciprocal partners, the following procedure must be followed:

Members wishing to play at a reciprocal course are required to first book their tee time directly with the host club, subject to that club's availability and booking policies. Once a tee time has been secured, the member must contact the Glacier Greens Golf Club Professional Staff to request reciprocal confirmation.

A member of our Golf Professional team will then contact the host club to verify the member's status and confirm the reciprocal arrangement. Reciprocal privileges are not considered confirmed until this verification has been completed and acknowledged by the host club.

Members are expected to respect all operational procedures, policies, and standards of the host club, including dress code, pace of play, and booking guidelines. While enjoying reciprocal privileges, members are representing Glacier Greens Golf Club and are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous, respectful, and professional manner at all times.

Reciprocal play is subject to the rules, restrictions, and applicable fees set by the host facility. Failure to follow the established reciprocal process or to adhere to host club policies may result in reciprocal privileges being declined or revoked.
